報告内容				
<p>Question # 14 asks about overall satisfaction with the course. 23 students gave the class an A, 5 students gave it a B, and no student gave the class a C.</p> <p>Two students in the class gave written comments. One liked the fact that I used English in class and that students had many opportunities to use English. Another student wrote that group discussion of stories read was interesting/beneficial.</p> <p>Most students thought the difficulty of the class and the assignments were reasonable, but a few students seemed to think the class was a little difficult. It is hard for me to know how to react to this. First of all, I think the course work should be challenging—and it is natural that some students feel it is difficult. This is natural, though I can understand what it is like for students to have trouble keeping up.</p> <p>It's important to have challenging content, so that students can develop both their English skills and their overall language skills.</p> <p>It's easier for me to know how to adjust the class difficulty if you come and talk to me directly. That way, you can tell me exactly what troubles you are having, and I can know what effort you are making.</p>
